



**Search:** wave, splash, bubbles, bubbly water, swirls, sparks, etc.

*Experiment with different search terms!*

Save any interesting images (whatever catches your eye, remember -- this is the 'hunt and forage' stage) to your project folder ('DrinkDesign') on your desktop. Remember to click on the image and then click on 'View Original Image' to get the full-sized resolution.

To open your images in Photoshop to use for layering, drag the image icon onto your Photoshop icon in your dock or go to Photoshop - File - Open and choose the image file you want.

**REMEMBER:** The objective is to make a believable drink design. So, download a barcode or create a barcode with a dafont.com font, include a nutrition panel, include a recycling symbol, list fluid ounces, etc. *Look at real examples of cans at the front of the class and replicate parts.*

## OPTIONS:

- Layer brushes onto your design (custom brushes you made or downloaded from BrushEezy or Brush King, etc.)
- Include a catch phrase?
- Have a background texture or color gradient?
- Create drawings or art that you scan to layer into Photoshop for your design (use whatever materials you want!) This could include drips, splatters, energetic marks, etc. to enliven the 'background'!
